**Prep2University** prepares you to pass the "Feststellungsprüfung" in the first of two possible attempts. Even for students qualified for direct university admission, this course offers an excellent preparation for their studies.

You may choose between two courses, according to your preliminary knowledge:

- **February to May**  
in four months to the final examination

#### Requirements for the entrance examination:

very good previous knowledge in German (min. B2 CEF) and mathematics as well as physics and chemistry (technology / natural sciences branch) or economics (economics branch)

- **October to May**  
in eight months to the final examination

#### Requirements for the entrance examination:

Basic level skills in German (min. B1 CEF) and very good mathematical skills

#### Admission

Admission to the preparatory course is based on passing the entrance examination at the beginning of the course.

### Courses

The courses are offered to prepare for technical study fields or economics.

#### Examination-relevant subjects and number of hours per week:
