Requirements

- Age: from 15 years, some exceptions possible
- German Language Level B1(CEF)
- Closing date for applications:
 - by end of March for whole school year
 - by end of March or end of September for half-year

Length of Stay

- A whole school year: August/September to June/ July
- A half-year: February to June/ July

What are the advantages of attending school in Germany? Foreign language acquisition at an early age, combined with a stay abroad, is of great benefit for the personal and academic development of young people. Spending six months or a whole year in a German school provides children with a unique opportunity to develop their linguistic and social competence.

As a rule Carl Duisberg Centren organizes attendance from Year 9 or 10. The selected schools are equivalent to the high schools in Anglo-Saxon countries. The school year in Germany is made up of two half-years: the first starting between July and September, depending on the region, the second starting in February.

Carl Duisberg Centren finds a suitable school for each student based on a personal and academic profile which reflects individual interests and academic focus. We are responsible for all communication between the school and the parents and provide regular progress reports on academic performance and social behavior. We also provide a personal mentor for the student for the first six months if required.

During their stay the pupils live with a German host family chosen by you. However, we are happy to assist in finding a suitable family, should you wish it.

Carl Duisberg Centren also organizes placements at renowned German boarding schools, which charge school fees, as well as International Schools or schools which offer the International Baccalaureate.
